## Other Aromatics

<b>TWR</b> – <i>Te Whare Ra “Toru”</i> – <i>Marlborough</i> TORU which means “three” in Maori is an aromatic blend. It has the aromatic spice and weight of Gewürztraminer, the structure and length of Riesling, and the great texture of Pinot Gris.	9	14.5	43
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**Trinity Hill Arneis** – *Hawkes Bay* 9 15 43  
 Delicate aromas of pear, almond and mineral are evident, which is typical of this variety in its native Italy.

**Spy Valley Gewurztraminer** - Marlborough 10 16 48  
 Fruit-driven in style, typically with intense aromas of rose-petal, Turkish delight and lychee

**Te Whare Ra Gewurztraminer** - Marlborough 13 20 63  
 Intensely perfumed, with notes of lychees, rose-petals, Ripe quince and cloves, with underlying characters of ginger, Fresh pear and exotic spice.

## Pinot Noir

**Rabbit Ranch** – *Central Otago* 11 17 53  
 Medium depth cherry red with a crimson-purple glow. Savoury smelling With the sweetness of oak and cherry fruit pushing through

**Mt Difficulty Roaring Meg** – *Central Otago* 12.5 19.5 61  
 A mix of berry fruits and liquorice with further complexity gained From oak spice.

**Mt Rosa** – *Central Otago* 13 20 63  
 Wild exotic fruit aromatics, followed by a warm rich and spicy Texture with lively acidity and freshness with a lasting finish

**Martinborough Vineyard Te Tera** – *Martinborough* 13 20 63  
 Attractive ripe dark fruits resonate from the glass with hints Of floral and spice characters adding complexity to the wine.

**Three Miners** – *Central Otago* 65  
 A vibrantly fruity red with cherry and spice flavours gently seasoned With toasty oak and ripe, supple tannins.

**Main Divide Te Hau** – *Waipara* 14 23 69  
 The wine has a vibrant ruby sheen, behind which lie layers of Dark ripe fruit characters. The nose and flavours suggest Black cherries, purple plums and blackberries.

**Wither Hills** – *Marlborough* 72  
 A wonderful core of spice, ripe fragrant plum, and rich brambly forest fruit Command the aromatics,

**Peregrine** – *Central Otago* 79  
 Moderately dense purple/ruby. Deep, rich, sensuous pinotesque aromatics Of fruits of the forest and savoury oak. Full-bodied to the taste with a fine, Silk-edged velvety texture.

**Two Paddocks** – *Central Otago* 85  
 Brambles, blackcurrants and dusty blackberry with dried herbal notes. Good mid palate density with light chalky tannins. (Sam Neill)

**Pegasus Bay** – *Waipara* 95  
 Bright ruby colour with aromas and flavours suggestive of black cherries, Purple plums, blackberries and raspberries. There is a savoury underlay Of roast game, grilled bacon and mushrooms.

## Syrah/Shiraz

**Curious** - Victoria 9 14.5 43

Subtly integrated American oak balanced with ripe plums and blackberries  
Aromas of chocolate, spice and dark fruits.

**Plantagenet Omrah – Western Australia** 10 16 49  
Pepper and berry notes with subtle oak characters which impart  
sweet vanilla And cinnamon aromas.

**Weeping Sands Syrah – Waiheke Island** 11 17.5 52  
Ripe blackcurrant and plum along with lifted floral notes and fragrant  
vanilla spice.The palate is structurally focused with generous sweet fruit  
and fine ripe tannins.

**Jim Barry Lodge hill - Clare valley** 12 19.5 58  
Lifted aromas of mulberry, raspberry, coffee and kirsch. The bramble,  
Chocolate and rosemary flavours that are present  
In fill the mouth.

**Penfolds Bin 128 - Coonawarra** 62  
An initial rush of juiciness and lush core fruits - rhubarb/plum/raspberry,  
Underpinned by mouthwatering acidity and a small measure of stylish French oak.

**Trinity Hill Gimblett Gravels Syrah – Hawkes Bay** 13 20 63  
Blackberry, black pepper, savoury and spice elements are prominent,  
With meaty overtones. The Viognier has added a lifted aromatic quality.

**Craggy Range Block 14 Gimblett Gravels – Hawkes Bay** 15 24.5 73  
Deep red colour with vivid purple hues. An intense array of pepper,  
Black cherry, sandalwood and liquorice notes form a complex nose.

**St Hallett Old Block - Barossa Valley** 95  
Blackberries, blueberries, raspberries, cassis and dark plums tightly knit  
with sweet, gamey chocolate-like oak and underpinned by fine, crunchy  
tannin. It's spicy and aromatic, laced throughout by nuances of cloves and cinnamon

**Penfolds RWT 05, 06 – Barossa Valley** 250  
Aged in 70% new French oak hogsheads. The bouquet shows off aromas of pain grille,  
Pencil lead, damp earth, pepper, game, blueberry, and blackberry liqueur.  
Velvety textured, supple, ripe and succulent, this elegant effort is impeccably balanced

## Red Blends

**Angus the Bull – Cabernet Sauvignon – South Australia** 8.5 13.5 39  
Ripe black fruits with rich dark chocolate and vanillin smoky oak aromas  
An ideal accompaniment to red meat and premium cuts of prime beef.

**Penfolds Koonunga Hill – Shiraz Cabernet - South Australia** 10 16 48  
A rich, amply proportioned wine with layers of blackberry, blackcurrant  
And plum fruit cradled in subtle oak

**Penfolds bin 138 – GMS – Barossa valley** 60  
A blend of Grenache Mourvedre Shiraz.Warm Barossa primary fruits  
merge into a pool of liqueur cherryAnd chocolate heightened by cherry pip tannins

**Pegasus Bay – Merlot Cabernet - Waipara** 13 20 62  
Medium bodied in style and savoury, meaty and spicy, lots of brambles.  
A blend of Merlot, Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc with two  
Years in oak barriques

**Pegasus Bay Maestro - Waipara** 85  
A blend of 85% Merlot and 15% Malbec which has a meaty richness

With violets hints of chocolate with ripe dusty blackberry aroma.

**Penfolds 707 – Cabernet Sauvignon - South Australia** 250  
Bin 707 is Penfolds' Cabernet Sauvignon version of Grange: ripe,  
Intensely-flavoured fruit; completing fermentation and maturation  
In new oak; fully expressing a Penfolds understanding of multi-vineyard,  
Multi-region fruit sourcing.

## Merlot

**Spy Valley - Marlborough** 9 14 43  
Mouthfilling and smooth, with ripe sweet fruit flavours of plums  
And currants. The structure is generous, smooth and long.

**Oyster Bay – Hawkes Bay** 9.5 15 46  
Ripe plum, berryfruits and hints of spice, accentuated with a nuance  
Of oak and an elegant, lingering soft texture.

**Charles Wiffen - Marlborough** 10 16 48  
An elegant expression of Marlborough Merlot. Rich layers of plum,  
Truffle and bright berry fruits

**Craggy Range Gimblett Gravels – Hawkes Bay** 14 23 69  
Dollops of ripe fruit flavours and a hint of oak derived mocha  
Character to form a luscious and long palate

## Dessert Wines

**The Ned Noble - Marlborough** 11.5 55  
Layers of rich, ripe melon and real botrytis characters fill the palate.  
Lusciousness on the front of the palate with a clean crisp finish

**Trinity Hill Noble Viognier – Hawkes Bay** 65  
Luscious & concentrated with strong flavours of dried fruits, especially  
Apricots.

**TWR – Te Whare Ra – Noble Riesling - Marlborough** 70  
Lifted aromas of honeysuckle, apricots, orange rind and manuka honey

## Worldwide

**Trapiche Broquel Malbec - Argentina** 12.5 20 63  
Intense, deep red-violet colour, almost black, showing the concentration  
And quality of the fruit's origins.

**Guigal Cotes du Rhone - France** 13.5 22 66  
Full, round and racy. Rounded and smooth tannins. A full-bodied, rich  
And intensely aromatic wine.

**Staggs Leap – Cabernet Sauvignon – Napa Valley California** 95  
Round supple tannins wrapped around layers of blackberry, espresso and black truffle

## Ports

Founded in 1678, Croft is one of the original port houses and occupies a place of great distinction in the history of port wine. The company specialises in vintage and vintage-style ports and has produced many legendary wines.

### **Croft Fine Ruby**

7

Full bodied and firm, the palate is crammed with luscious black fruit flavours. It is particularly good with blue-veined and richly flavoured soft cheeses.

### **Croft 10 Year Old**

10

Complex nose full of mellow spicy aromas and hints of walnut, butterscotch and fine oak wood against a background of rich jammy fruit.

### **Croft Distinction**

8

Elegant berry-fruit nose redolent of raspberry and blackcurrant with notes of cherry and ripe plum. Firm, full bodied palate crammed with juicy fruit flavours and with a succulent strawberry jam finish.

### **Croft Vintage 2003**

15

Very deep purple black with a narrow purple rim. Extraordinarily powerful and heady nose with an almost overpowering abundance of jammy fruit in which blackberry, blackcurrant and cherry combine with fine aromatic notes of guncistus. Big mouth-filling palate, crammed with rich, thick tannins and bursting with luscious fruity flavour.
